To do the Pap test, your doctor or nurse scrapes a small sample of cells from your cervix and sends it to a laboratory. A technologist then looks at the cells under a microscope for signs of abnormal changes.

Even if you feel fine, you should still see your provider for regular checkups. These visits can help you avoid problems in the future. For example, the only way to find out if you have high blood pressure is to have it checked regularly. High blood sugar and high cholesterol levels also may not have any symptoms in the early stages. A simple blood test can check for these conditions.

Breast cancer is the second leading cause of cancer death in American women. Incidence tends to increase with age. About 95% of new cases occur in those who are 40 and older and 88% of breast cancer deaths occur in women 50 and older. Women in their 20s and 30s have the lowest incidence of breast cancer.

The Pap test and the HPV test look for different things. A Pap test checks the cervix for abnormal cell changes that, if not found and treated, can lead to cervical cancer. Your doctor takes cells from your cervix to examine under a microscope. How often you need a Pap test depends on your age and health history.

Breast cancer is the second leading cause of cancer death in American women. About 2 out of 3 breast cancers are found in women 55 or older and 1 out of 8 are found in women younger than 45. Regular screening can help to detect tumors at an early stage when they are most treatable.

Biopsy. The Pap test can be used as a screening test, but produces a false negative in up to 50% of cases of cervical cancer. Other concerns is the cost of doing pap tests which make it unaffordable in many areas of the world. Confirmation of the diagnosis of cervical cancer or precancer requires a biopsy of the cervix.
