Alliteration: Alliteration is the repetition of beginning consonant sounds. The tongue twister, "Peter Piper picked a peck of pickled peppers," overuses alliteration. Alliteration is easy to use, but it is a challenge to use it well when writing poetry. Look for excellent examples in "The Highwayman" by Alfred Noyes.

A "rhyme scheme" is a way of describing the pattern of end rhymes in a poem. Each new sound at the end of a line is given a letter, starting with "A," then "B," and so on.
