Functions of The Lymphatic System • Lymphatic capillaries reabsorb excessive tissue fluid and transport the fluid through the lymphatic pathway, and ultimately dispose it into the blood. • Lymphatic capillaries called Lacteals absorb certain fatty acids in the small intestine.

Lymph nodes filter the lymph that passes through the vessels and add lymphocytes to it. White blood cells that produce antibodies target foreign cells and attack them. Factoid: Overly large lymph nodes are red flags for doctors, usually indicating an infection or disease.

Functions of the Lymph System 1) Maintains volume and pressure of extracellular fluid by returning excess water and dissolved substances from the interstitial fluid to the circulation. 2) Lymph nodes and other lymphoid tissues are the site of clonal production of immunocompetent lymphocytes and macrophages in the specific immune response.
