For a discrete probability distribution, the mean is given by  $\sum x_i p(x_i)$ , where the sum is taken over all possible values of the random variable and  $p(x_i)$  is the probability mass function.

Mathematics: Pythagorean theorem  $a^2 + b^2 = c^2$ . The Pythagorean theorem states that in a right-angled triangle, the square of the length of the hypotenuse (the side opposite the right angle) is equal to the sum of the squares of the lengths of the other two sides. In other words,  $a^2 + b^2 = c^2$ , where  $c$  is the length of the hypotenuse, and  $a$  and  $b$  are the lengths of the other two sides.
